The International Sustainable Rice Forum (ISRF) 2025 comes at a pivotal moment when sustainable rice has become an integral part of global dialogues on food security, climate action, and agricultural transformation. Over the years, private sector actors, governments, researchers, CSOs, and farmers have increasingly recognised that building an enabling environment for sustainable rice requires a shared platform, one that brings together diverse stakeholders as part of a unified system to advance supportive policies, drive innovation and research, and mobilise resources effectively.

The Forum presents a strategic platform to exchange knowledge, strengthen collaboration, explore opportunities, and align global and regional priorities on sustainable rice development. The Forum will convene leading voices from across the value chain to address challenges and opportunities that shape the future of rice in a sustainable food system.

The ISRF 2025 is organised by Preferred by Nature together with the global Sustainable Rice Platform (SRP), Rikolto, and the International Rice Research Institute (IRRI), global leaders driving sustainable climate-smart rice production through standards, farmers empowerment and cutting-edge research.

It is part of the Low Carbon Rice project, funded by the European Union through its SWITCH-Asia Grants Programme and implemented by Preferred by Nature in collaboration with Koalisi Rakyat untuk Kedaulatan Pangan (KRKP) and indonesia Rice Millers and Traders Association (PERPADI).

About the venue

- The Discovery Convention Centre, Ancol is located on Jl. Lodan Timur No. 7, Ancol, North Jakarta, Indonesia. The site is approximately 7 kilometres from Jakarta's Central Business District, with direct toll road access to and from Soekarno-Hatta International Airport and the Port of Tanjung Priok, as well as close proximity to Jakarta Kota Railway Station.
- · Discovery Convention Centre is part of the **Ancol Taman Impian complex**, which also includes Discovery Hotel & Resort. Ancol Taman Impian complex also has plenty of leisure and entertainment attractions such as Dunia Fantasi (Dufan), Seaworld, and Ancol Beach, making it a convenient location that blends business and leisure.
- The venue features a flexible convention hall and several meeting rooms, all equipped with modern facilities and air conditioning, designed to host a wide variety of events including conferences, exhibitions, corporate gatherings, and cultural performances.

By Car/Taxi (approx. 30 – 45 minutes) with price estimates €12:

- · Take Jl. Raya Bandara Soekarno-Hatta to Jl. Tol Airport Prof. Sedyatmo.
- · Continue on Jl. Tol Airport Prof. Sedyatmo. Take Jl. Tol Pelabuhan.
- · Take the exit toward **Ancol Senen/Gn. Sahari/Mangga Dua** from Jl. Tol Pelabuhan.
- Take Jl. Karang Bolong VI, Jl. Karang Bolong Raya, Jl. Pelabuhan Ratu and Jl. Puri Marina Raya to your destination in 10 minutes.

Entry to Ancol Taman Impian Complex

- All participants of International Sustainable Rice Forum 2025 are exempt of individual entry fee to enter Ancol Taman Impian Complex.
- · If you are using taxi/ride hailing services, you are highly advised to use **Blue Bird Taxi/Grab/Gojek**. These three services partner with the Ancol complex and has **automatic exemption** on the taxi entry fee when entering Ancol Taman Impian Complex.
- · If you are using **private car,** you may show your **event barcode** (provided on to you after finalising registration) to ensure that your private car will also be exempt of car entry fee.
